We started with 22 founding members in 2004 and are nearly 200 members strong today. Our members include family caregivers, disability and aging community agency staff, state agency employees, and university and independent researchers. Virginia received a Lifespan Respite Grant from the Administration on

Aging in 2011 to support respite services for family caregivers. This grant continues to enhance the VCC's caregiver support efforts across the lifespan.
